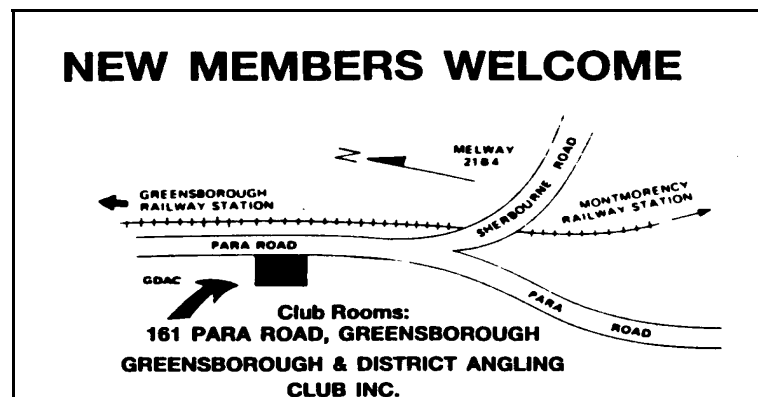

The fishing could have been better with only 7 members weighing in fish over the 2 days. Russell weighing in 3.17kg Mark weighing in 2.86kg and Carl with 2.29kg. Carl also had the heaviest fish which weighed 1.21kg and a length of 41cm

13 Members travelled the 5 hours to Khancoban at the bottom of the Snowy Mountains and hope to land one of the great fish that are in this lake. With many members heading up Thursday to get the extra day of fishing in on the Friday

The Friday turned out to be an overcast day and not too cold with a few fish landed for the day.

Day 2 was a different story with the weather report saying snow to 500 meters strong winds and what ever it could throw at us. The day started fine with no wind or rain in sight and some good fish being landed while trolling. At 9-00am things turned dark and the rain came in buckets then stopped and started for the rest of the day.

Most people measured in on the Saturday night and then headed to the pub for a meal and watch the football.

On the Sunday the weather was not too bad with only the odd minor shower and a few fish measured in. Ross Ayton made a great comeback on the Sunday with 5 fish totalling a length of 2560mm to snatch 3rd. The longest fish was a 600mm Brown trout followed by a lot of fish between 530mm and 585mm. A total length from all fish measured came to over 24 meters in length.
